

Lunenburg Town Beach

Rules & Regulations

1. Swimming allowed in designated areas only
2. Swimmers must **NOT** interfere with swim lesson sessions
3. No alcoholic beverages will be possessed or consumed at the beach and no person shall be intoxicated
4. No person shall commit any obscene or indecent act or use profane/obscene language.
5. Carry in/ Carry out policy
 - a. No littering
 - b. All trash brought in must be brought out
 - c. No glass containers will be allowed on the beach
 - d. No household trash allowed in rubbish containers in restrooms
6. No person shall damage, deface, or remove any building, structure, or sign belonging to the Town of Lunenburg
7. **Smoking is prohibited**
8. Do **NOT** throw rocks, sand, clamshells, etc
9. No selling, advertising, or giving away of goods and services will be permitted except by concessionaires under contract with the Town or by written permission from the Recreation Department and Park Commission
10. Fire, charcoal or gas grills are **NOT** allowed
11. No animals or pets are permitted on any area of the beach, with the exception of service animals
12. No person shall disturb the peace and tranquility of others
13. Children (15) years of age or younger **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or person (18) years of age or older responsible for his or her behavior within the beach area
14. Ball playing, kite flying and frisbee playing are permitted at the discretion of lifeguards only
15. Scuba diving and skin diving are prohibited in designated swimming areas
16. Sailboats, canoes, kayaks, windsurfers, surfboards, bodyboards, etc are prohibited from swimming areas
17. Beach umbrellas are permitted at the discretion of the lifeguards
18. Fishing is not permitted in swimming areas
19. The use of drones is prohibited on the beach

20. Bathing suits are **REQUIRED**
21. **No changing clothes on the beach** with the exception of infants
22. Coast Guard approved life vests and lifejackets are allowed
 - a. Swimmers utilizing life vests and/or jackets **MAY NOT** swim in the deep end
23. Use of rafts, tubes, inflatables, and other similar types of floatation devices are prohibited, including water wings, foam pool noodles, and suits with foam inserts
24. Closures:
 - a. The Recreation Director and the Beach Director reserve the right to close areas to swimming based on health/safety concerns and weather concerns
25. Hours
 - a. Monday thru Friday 10 AM - 7 PM
 - b. Saturday + Sunday 12PM - 6 PM
 - c. Restricted swimming from 10 AM - 12 PM during swim lessons
 - d. Unless otherwise authorized, the beach is closed to the general public from 6 PM thru 12 PM Saturday + Sunday and 7 PM thru 10 AM Monday thru Friday
26. Park and beach officials and lifeguards must be obeyed in the enforcement of the above regulations and in any other other situation in which the judgement of the lifeguard must be exercised for the protection and safety of persons using the beach facilities
